



PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Dear Parents, Carers and families,

As you may be aware the Premier has extended lockdown in regional NSW until Friday 10 September at midnight (announced on Thursday 26 August). This means that we are continuing with 'Learning from Home' for another 2 weeks.

However, the Department of Education announced on Friday 27 August, a return to school plan on Friday for students in Term 4.

We understand that this may be causing some concern and confusion. As such, these are the two scenarios which we are working with and awaiting a government announcement next week.

If the NSW Government announces regional areas to be removed from stay-at-home rules, schools in those areas will return to school under Level 3 settings. This is a full return for all cohorts to schools, with reduced mingling and on-site activities. (possibly as early as Monday 13 September, 2021 (Week 10, Term 3).

If the NSW Government announces next week that regional areas are to remain on stay-at-home rules, students will return to face-to-face learning with NSW Health-approved COVID-safe settings on school sites in the following order:

- from 25 October – Kindergarten and Year 1
- from 1 November – Years 2, 6 and 11
- from 8 November – Years 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9 and 10.

Students in Year 12 and those completing their HSC are already able to return in a limited way and this will continue for the remainder of Term 3. From 25 October, these students will have full-time access to school campuses and their teachers.

As such, our school will continue to be open with minimal supervision to support those students who cannot be educated from home, for example if their parent or carer is an essential worker. All students and families will be supported with learning from home materials and resources provided by your teacher.

We thank you for your continued support and understanding as we work to keep everyone safe.

Miss Pollock's year 11 Hospitality class made hot and cold beverages during their practical lesson this term.





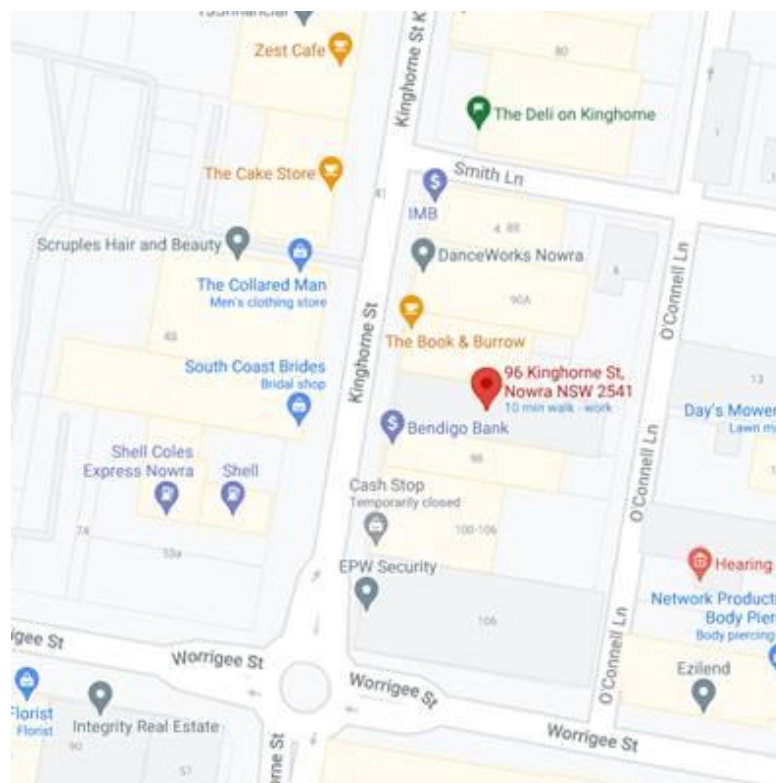
